The Department of Conservation and Energy (C&E) has received the referenced request of a letter of no objection for Global Splash Inc. to utilize treated municipal wastewater, meeting the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality discharge requirements, for the purpose of hydraulic fracturing operations.

C&E hereby states that is has no objection to Global Splash Inc. utilizing such wastewater as described above. Such municipal wastewater shall be used solely for industrial purposes directly associated with hydraulic fracturing activities and shall be managed in full compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, regulations, permits, and safety requirements. This determination of no objection is expressly conditioned upon compliance with approved volumes, authorized transportation methods, and any terms, conditions, or limitations imposed by the applicable governing or regulatory authority.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to waive, modify, or otherwise relieve any operator within the State of Louisiana from the obligation to obtain all additional approvals, authorizations, or permits required by applicable regulatory agencies..
